





### Lewis J. Abrams, ACSW, LCSW, CASAC, CSAT

Lewis J. Abrams has been treating those afflicted with addictions and mental health challenges including adolescents, adults, couples and families for the past 33 years. He has created and directed programs at all levels of care including traditional outpatient, partial hospitalization, intensive outpatient and residential services throughout New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania. Mr. Abrams was the Clinical Director of Marworth Treatment Center (1991 –2001), a nationally recognized system of addiction treatment services located outside of Scranton, Pennsylvania.



### Aryeh Buchsbayew, LCSW

Aryeh Buchsbayew is a New York State licensed clinical social worker and has worked in the field of substance abuse and addiction since 2005. Aryeh is trained in CBT, DBT, and EMDR and specializes in trauma work. Currently serving as a clinical supervisor at OHEL Children's Home and Family Services, Aryeh is also clinical coordinator at The Living Room (TLR), a program for Jewish young adults in recovery. Aryeh is co-author of Stepping Out of The Abyss: A Jewish guide to Recovery. Aryeh received his master's degree in social work from Fordham University in 2012. Aryeh also maintains a private practice in Woodmere, NY where he lives with his wife and children.



### Sharon Burns-Carter, CAC

Sharon Burns-Carter has extensive experience working with individuals suffering from Substance Use Disorders and their family members. Her focus is on innovative transitional protocols for clients as they move through the continuum of care, as well as ongoing guidance for family members as they heal. In addition to her skilled approach to recovery management, Sharon has extensive experience in program and staff development. On a personal note, Sharon Burns-Carter is a woman in long term recovery and the proud mom of two sons in long term recovery. Sharon believes that peer support, community and service isat the heart of sustained recovery and a fulfilled life.







### Rabbi Dov Greenberg

Rabbi Dov Greenberg leads Stanford Chabad and lectures across the world. From his student center at Stanford University, lots of people like this Rabbi. We're talking millions. With an army of Facebook followers, Rabbi Dov Greenberg is a trailblazing Chassidic teacher with a knack for condensing deep mystical concepts into compact, relevant sound bites that resonate across mediums and mentalities. He's no stranger to what Judaism means to a new, thinking generation. His essays on contemporary issues appear regularly in newspapers and on the Internet. He lives with his family in Palo Alto, California.



### Rabbi Simon Jacobson

Rabbi Simon Jacobson is one of the greatest scholars and sought after speakers in the Jewish world today. He has lectured to diverse audiences on six continents and in forty states on psycho-spiritual issues and applying Jewish thought to contemporary life. His voice is rooted in the timeless teachings of Torah, yet at the same time is profoundly timely, relevant, unique, and cutting edge. For over 14 years Rabbi Jacobson, as Editor-in-Chief of Vaad Hanochos Hatmimim, was responsible for publishing the talks of the late Rabbi Menachem M. Schneerson, the Lubavitcher Rebbe. He was privileged to work in close association with the Rebbe and published more than 1000 of the Rebbe's talks. Rabbi Jacobson also heads The Meaningful Life Center, which bridges the secular and

the spiritual, through a wide variety of live and on-line programming. The Meaningful Life Center presents to people of all backgrounds the universal teachings of Torah as a blueprint for life. He is the author of the best-selling book Toward a Meaningful Life, a publication that has sold over 300,000 copies to date and has been translated into 14 languages.



### Devorah Kaplan

Devorah Kaplan is the Rebbetzin and program director of the Downtown Chabad Jewish Center in East Fort Lauderdale. Together with her husband Schneur, they founded the DJCC in 2001. Devorah has whole heartedly devoted herself to the fruition of the Jewish community in Fort Lauderdale, particularly in the arena of Jewish education. She received her teaching degree in France at the age of 19 and has made education the benchmark of her life and work. She is the founder and Director of a thriving Reggio Amelia Preschool and flourishing Hebrew School. Devorah has taught children and adults of all ages for over 20 years. She teaches a weekly women's class (since 2001), covering a breadth of topics from kabbalah, Talmud and biblical sources that attracts

women from all walks of life, from 'stay at home moms' to Doctors, grandmas, lawyers and therapists. She has passionately embraced and connected with the diverse Jews of Fort Lauderdale with her love, wisdom and thirst for knowledge and growth. Her enthusiasm and 'Joi De Vivre' is contagious and palpable in all she does. Devorah is married to Rabbi Schneur Kaplan and has seven children.







### Rabbi Schneur Kaplan

Rabbi Kaplan, fondly referred to by his friends as "Shneini", is the spiritual leader and rabbi of the Downtown Chabad Jewish Center in Fort Lauderdale FL. Together with his wife Devorah, they founded DJCC in 2001 and have been serving this diverse Jewish Community with devotion, love and acceptance embracing Jews from all backgrounds and ways of life! Rabbi Kaplan is a distinguished lecturer and inspiring teacher. He is also a cantor and musician, often performing uplifting and moving kumzits and spiritual farbrengens. In addition to his work in the Downtown Community, Rabbi Kaplan has devoted much of his time, energy and expertise in the world of recovery. He currently leads 2 groups in weekly spiritual sessions and is a personal mentor for numerous men

and women. He is beloved by many and respected for his tremendous work assisting and guiding the many who reach out to him for support. Rabbi Kaplan is married to Devorah Kaplan (nee Hecht) and is the father of 7 amazing children. BH!!



### **David Kaufman**

David Kaufman is a Narrative and Solution Focused Brief Therapist and Addictions counselor (C.A.A.C.F.). He has lectured and taught on a wide variety of mental health topics such as trauma, stress management and conflict resolution. As well as philosophic and theological issues. He has lectured throughout Israel and Canada, including York University, Hinks Dellcrest Family Therapy Center, Shaarei Tzedek Hospital, amongst others. In 1985 David received the Black Student Union Appreciation Award for his community work. David and his wife Estair lived in Bratislava, working for The Foundation for The Education and Welfare for Jews of Czechoslovakia, establishing the first Jewish school and educational program in Czechoslovakia since WWII. He also co-

founded the Narrative Therapy Center in Jerusalem, and was an honorary Staff member at the Hinks Dellcrest Institute as a member of a University of Toronto research project concerning Narrative Therapy techniques. Since that time he has been teaching, working for JACS, and maintaining a private practice in Toronto.



### Rabbi Meir Kessler

Rabbi Meir Kessler is the Director of the Jewish Recovery Center in Boca Raton Florida. He was ordained in 2001 by the Chief Rabbi of Jerusalem. Rabbi Kessler began his Rabbinical career as a pulpit Rabbi in Delray Beach. Before long he came to the realization that the area is inhabited by a very unique and special population, people in treatment and those in early recovery. Rabbi Kessler & his wife Frumi decided to dedicate their lives to serving this community and founded the Jewish Recovery Center for this purpose.








### Faith Niece, MA, LMHC, LMFT, CSAT

Faith Niece, MA, LMHC, LMFT, CSAT is a therapist in Boca Raton, FL, who helps clients to lead healthier, happier, more fulfilling lives. TLR, was the first Jewish program of its kind providing outreach and on-going support services specifically to Jewish young adults in recovery. Menachem is the co-author of Stepping Out of the Abyss: A Jewish Guide to the Twelve Steps, a Mosaica Press publication. Menachem received his master's degree in social work from the Yeshiva University Wurzweiler School of Social Work. Mr. Poznanski

maintains a private practice as a psychotherapist, and is also a consultant to high schools in addressing issues of substance abuse and addiction. Mr. Poznanski lives in Cedarhurst, New York, with his wife Naomi and their two children.



### Sarge Pickman

Sarge Pickman is an extraordinary entertainer. SARGE has performed worldwide to adoring audiences. His sidesplitting comedy, touching vocals and stunning display of dexterity as a pianist have wowed crowds for decades. He is one of the highest energy, multi-talented acts in show business today. Not only a hysterical stand-up comedian, SARGE sings in his own voice and a dozen others including Harry Connick, Jr., Sammy Davis, Jr., Lionel Richie and Stevie Wonder. Additionally, his dead on impressions of Marv Albert, Mike Tyson, Kermit the Frog and Gilbert Gottfried leave audiences howling and clamoring for more. SARGE has been clean and sober since December 26, 1990, and he

has dedicated himself to assisting others who are facing the battle of addiction.







### Rabbi Dr. Abraham J. Twerski

Rabbi Dr. Abraham Twerski is a psychiatrist and founder of Gateway Rehabilitation Center in Pittsburgh, one of America's leading facilities for addiction treatment. He is the author of more than 70 books, and lectures extensively on the topics of chemical dependency, stress, self-esteem and spirituality. For 20 years, he served as clinical director of the Department of Psychiatry at St. Francis Hospital in Pittsburgh, and was associate professor of psychiatry at the University of Pittsburgh's School of Medicine. Rabbi Twerski is recognized as an international authority in the chemical dependency field. He began the first Pennsylvania program for nurses with alcohol or drug problems,

"Nurses off Chemicals," served on the Governor's Council on Drug and Alcohol Abuse, and was Chairman of the Pennsylvania Medical Society Committee on the impaired Physician. Rabbi Dr. Twerski is an ordained rabbi, and traces his ancestry to the Baal Shem Tov, founder of the Chassidic movement.



### Arnie Wexler, CCGC LCADC

Arnie Wexler, CCGC LCADC has presented educational work shops nationally and internationally. Arnie is a recovering compulsive gambler whose last bet was April 10, 1968. Arnie also run's a national help line (888.LAST.BET) and works at Recovery Road, a treatment facility in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida that specializes in the treatment of those suffering with gambling addiction.



### Moshe A. Yachnes LMSW, CSAT, CASACT

Moshe A. Yachnes LMSW, CSAT, CASACT, graduated from Fordham University with a masters degree in clinical social work. He has extensively trained in addictions therapy as well as fulfilled therequirements for a credentialed alcohol and substance abuse counselor (CASAC). In 2007, Moshe was awarded with a specialization in education and training in substance abuse. He has worked with individuals and families struggling with abuse and addiction for ten years including two years as weekend supervisor at MLN National Jewish Youth Rehabilitation, an inpatient dual diagnosis residential facility for

Jewish adolescents. Moshe has been trained by the International Institute for Trauma and Addiction Professionals (IITAP), and is a certified sex addiction therapist (CSAT). He has been acknowledged by the BECK Institute for his training in CBT interventions. Moshe served as clinical director of Madraigos in Woodmere N.Y where he was responsible to all therapeutic programing. He spent 3 years providing psychotherapy in private practice in Cedarhurst NY.
